A few words of introduction by Irena Szynek, the headmaster



The Economic School Complex in Leszno meets the expectations of the environment and develops and introduces courses needed by the local market. The school cooperates with numerous companies with numerous companies, uses modern information technologies. Teachers are encouraged to exchange experience, solve problems together, and seek new directions for development. The school's premises and sports facilities are being successively improved.

We are concluding more and more beneficial partnership agreements for the school. We are a leader in the town and region in terms of organising paid internships abroad and in the town. We nurture comprehensive contacts with friendly schools from all over the world.

Between 2016 and 2022, the school implemented 19 projects and received accreditation as part of the Erasmus+ programme. Our students are winners and finalists of competitions and national Olympiads. They achieve high results in vocational and matriculation examinations. More than 70 students received the Leszno Laurel of Education in 2015-2022. The school tops *Perspektywy* ranking, winning gold, silver and bronze shields over the years. ZSE has been the best logistics school in Poland for several years.

On a daily basis, we do not neglect the work of shaping civic and patriotic attitudes in students. People and animals can count on our help, the school's voluntary service is thriving, and we help students develop their talents in all aspects. We educate young people who are indifferent to the world around them, who are active, curious and bold in making life decisions.

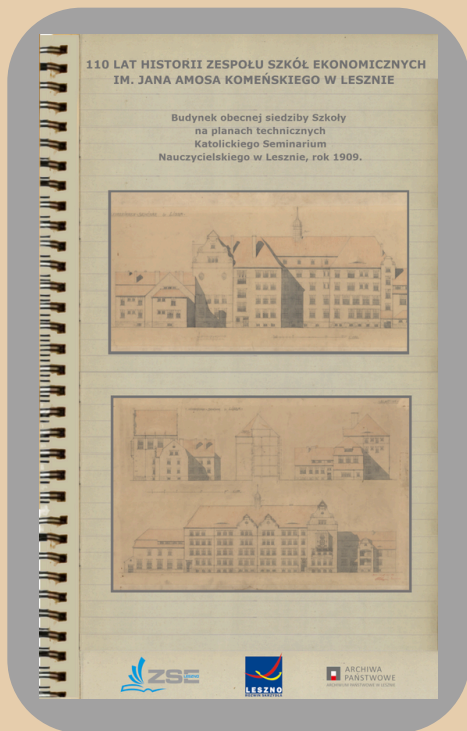

School calendar

1912 r. - establishment of a vocational school called Handels und Gewerbeschule in the present building of Primary School no. 3 on Jan Amos Comenius Square

1920 r. - takeover of the school by the Polish education authorities; name given to the State Industrial and Commercial School.

1925 r. - visit of the President of the Republic of Poland Stanisław Wojciechowski

1925 r. - 1 września - transfer of the school to a new building at 2 Kurpińskiego Street; division of the institution into three separate units: State Co-educational Gymnasium of Merchants, State Female Gymnasium of Tailoring, State Annual School of Underwear and Tailoring, State School of Family Adaptation of 1st degree, Secondary School of Construction

1945 r. - 15 kwietnia - starting lessons in a liberated country

1945/1946 - change of name to National Grammar and Secondary School of Commerce; the first secondary school-leaving examination in the school's history is held

1950 r. - moving the school to the building on Kościuszki Square

1950-1964 - recruitment of students for the following courses: Commercial Technical School, Catering Technical School, Basic Vocational School

1959 r. - 1 września - change of name to Technical School of Economics

1964 r. - 12 października - establishment of the scout troop

1967 r. - commencement of activities of the 4-year Secondary School of Economics

1970 r. - transfer of the school to the building at 2 Poniatowskiego Street

1972 r. - 15 kwietnia - ceremony to name the school after Jan Amos Komensky, with the unveiling of the bust of the patron and the presentation of the school banner

1973 r. - awarding, for the first time, the title of "Meritorious Student of the School"

1975/1976 - change of name to Zespół Szkół Ekonomicznych

1979/1980 - the school had 1798 pupils

1990/1991 - establishment of schools: Secondary School of Economics, Vocational School Complex, Secondary Vocational School, Post-secondary Vocational School

1992 r. - 80th school anniversary

1994/1995 - creation of a 5-year Hotel Management Technical School

1994/1995 - the school had 2200 pupils

1995 r. - 21 stycznia - organisation of the 1st RUN Parent-Student-Teacher Tournament

1997 r. - receiving the title of Distinguished Service to the City of Leszno

2000/2001 - the school had 1831 pupils

2002 r. - 90th school anniversary

2003 r. - opening of the simulation company "SymEk"

2004/2005 - creation of a catering technician school

2004/2005 - commissioning of two catering laboratories and a consumer service room

2006 r. - opening of the Multimedia Information Centre

2007/2008 - creation of a logistics technical school

2007 r. - receiving the Entrepreneurship School certificate
